Frequently asked questions on the request for research proposals

Q 1: Can authors from outside South Africa apply to the request for research proposals?

A 1: Yes. SA-TIED welcomes all candidates to apply.

Q 2: How much is the remuneration for an SA-TIED working paper?

A 2: Remunerations for SA-TIED working papers range from 4,000 USD to 10,000 USD depending on the experience level of the (lead) researcher. For research groups, a contract is issued for the lead researcher, who is responsible for distributing the remuneration to their co-authors.

Q 3: What is the standard length of an SA-TIED working paper?

A 3: Working papers are expected to be between 8,000 to 10,000 words. Authors are requested to observe the Style Guidelines for preparing WIDER Working Papers, available on our website: www.wider.unu.edu/node/75151.
